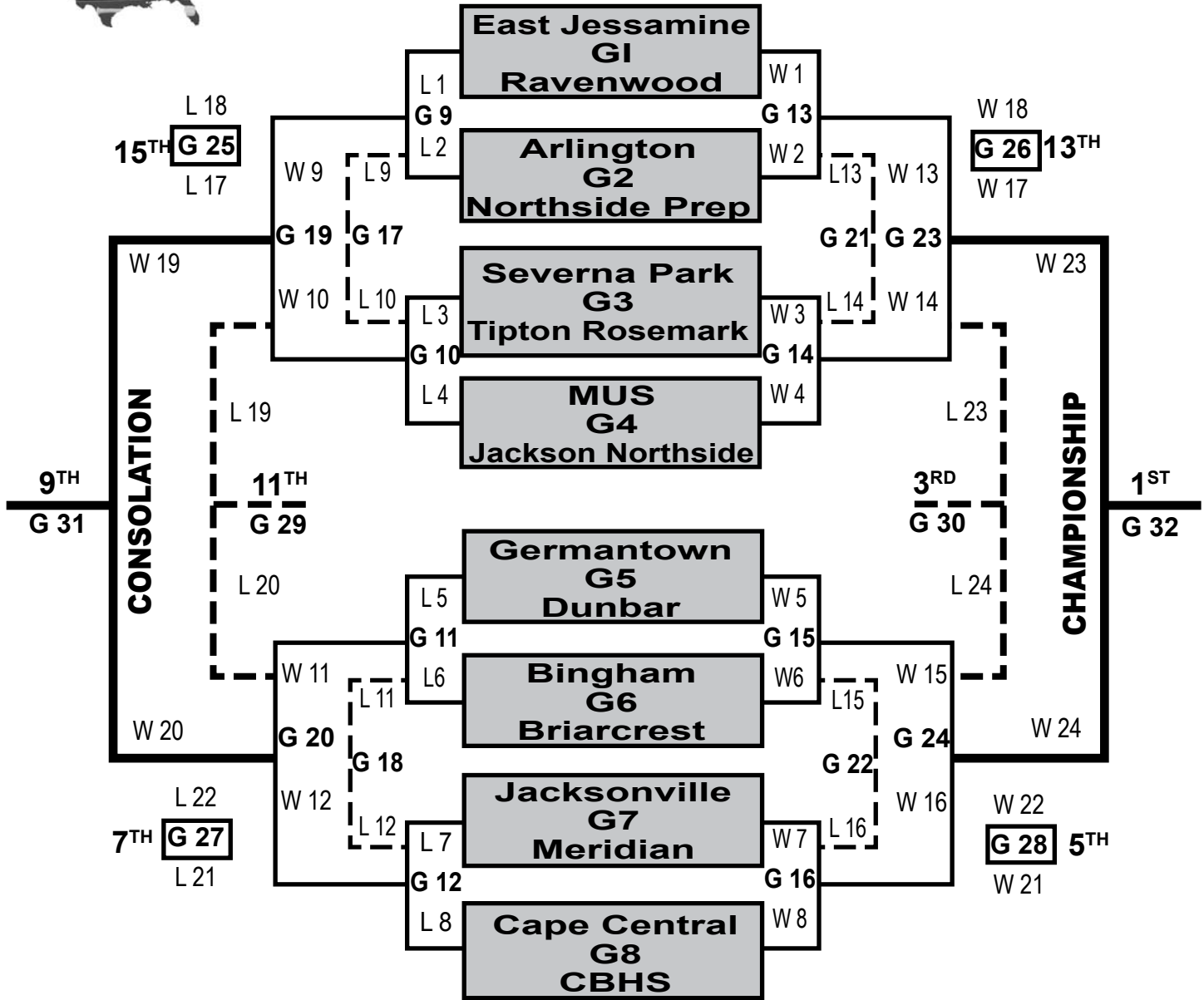

# 20<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL USA CLASSIC

APRIL 4<sup>TH</sup> - APRIL 7<sup>TH</sup>, 2012

The field is set for the 2012 USA Classic, to be held at USA Stadium and Christian Brothers High School. Below is a thumbnail description of each high school team, representing nine states.

## **ARLINGTON HIGH SCHOOL (TENNESSEE)**

Public / 2300 Enrollment

District Champions led them to a 2011 State Runner up finish. Compiled a 33-6 record and return 7 starters. Several college prospects on the 2012 squad make them a strong contender to return to the state play-offs again

## **BINGHAM HIGH SCHOOL (Utah)**

Public / 2400 Enrollment

Defending State Champions that finished 27-3 in 2011. Ranked in the top 20 of several national polls at the end of 2010. Always a competitive well coached team. With the players that return they may repeat.

## **BRIARCREST CHRISTIAN (Tennessee)**

Private / 575 Enrollment

All starters and top pitchers return from a 3<sup>rd</sup> place Regional finish. Should be in the hunt for a top finish in this year's USA Classic. Expectations for a strong season are very high.

## **CAPE CENTRAL (Missouri)**

Public / 1,250 Enrollment

Last year's Final 8 state finish shows that these guys know how to play. Several college and possible draft prospects complete their roster. Last year they were District and Sectional Champions.

## **CHRISTIAN BROTHERS HIGH SCHOOL (Tennessee)**

Private, all male / 855 Enrollment.

2011 State Champions that lost six players to college baseball last year. Looking to rebuild with solid core of young players that are eager to attempt a repeat. Should get better each month

## **DUNBAR HIGH SCHOOL (Kentucky)**

Public / 2100 Enrollment

2011's 24-12 finish gives ta good indication that this team expects to play with the best. They finished in top 10 of polls last year. And won state title in 2007. A solid group of players look to advance a little further in 2012.

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## **EAST JESSAMINE (Kentucky)**

Public / 1100 Enrollment

A District Runner-Up in 2011 with 8 returning starters give a lot of hope for this season. Several college prospects dot their roster. First year coach brings a good chance for this bunch to win several tournaments throughout the year.

## **GERMANTOWN HIGH SCHOOL (Tennessee)**

Public / 1800 Enrollment

Last year's District Championship and their 25-12 finish proved what a quality group this is. A long, traditional power house and several top returning players gives every reason that they could win their fourth USA Classic Championship.

## **JACKSON NORTHSIDE (Tennessee)**

Public / 1200 Enrollment

2011 Regional Runner-Up, 2010 and 2011 District Champions display the caliber of baseball these guys bring to the tournament. 6 returning starters along with their 3 top pitchers give them a chance at their first USA Classic Championship.

## **JACKSONVILLE HIGH SCHOOL (Illinois)**

Public / 990 Enrollment

8 players return from last year's 19-15 finish. That and several college prospects from their underclassmen hold out hope for a strong tournament candidate. Play in a tough Illinois league that will prepare them to compete with the best.

## **MEMPHIS UNIVERSITY SCHOOL (Tennessee)**

Private all male / 500 Enrollment

State Runner-Up in 2011 and 2010. 6 returning starters and their top pitchers returning make this one of the top teams in the area. Should have a chance to win each game they play as their roster has several college prospects.

## **MERIDIAN HIGH SCHOOL (Mississippi)**

Public / 1700 Enrollment

First time participant of the USA Classic. They play in probably the toughest league in the state. Always competitive and produce college prospects on a regular basis. New, experienced coach brings high expectations.

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## **NORTHSIDE COLLEGE PREP HIGH SCHOOL (Illinois)**

Public / 1200 Enrollment

A first place conference finish in 2011, making it to the final four with a 21-8 record and 7 returning starters make this a formidable opponent for anyone. All top pitchers return that are expected to play college baseball in 2013.

## **RAVENWOOLD HIGH SCHOOL (Tennessee)**

Public / 1800 Enrollment

2010 District and Regional Champions. Compete in a very tough district. First time participant in the USA Classic. Should be able to tell where they stand at tournament completion. Return a talented, young squad.

## **SEVERNA PARK HIGH SCHOOL (Maryland)**

Public / 1700 Enrollment

2011 State Runner-Up. State Champions in 2003, 2005 and 2009. Should make a good run in their first USA Classic appearance. Return 6 starters and 3 top pitchers from their 20-6, 2011 team.

## **TIPTON-ROSEMARK ACADEMY (Tennessee)**

Private / 180 Enrollment

A strong 29-13 season in 2011 that returns 7 starters provides for high hopes for the 2012 season. Made a strong run in the final play-offs last year and made their first ever Dandy Dozen appearance. Should have a great season.
